## **Surprise, surprise!**

Life delivers all kinds of surprises and in recent months on the national and world stage, Brexit and the advent of Mr Trump, certainly caused an intake of breath.

The element of surprise is embedded in the Christmas story; a surprised inn-keeper, surprised shepherds, surprised wise men, and of course surprised parents. Surprised children are always a delight to behold and at Christmastime, come into their own. The guesswork around those curiously shaped parcels, resting under the Christmas tree, suddenly release their hidden treasures. Eyes light up and shrieks of surprised delight.

Familiarity dulls surprise of course, and the older we become, our fascination with the festive season can become wearied, often accentuated with stress and pressure, and sometimes sensitively poignant because of absent friends and partners.

Nearly 2000 years ago, God took the world by surprise, and in this 21<sup>st</sup> Century, he wants to do the same.

**Thank you for all your support and prayer in 2016.** The year has flown by, but as I reflect on what has been accomplished, I am deeply encouraged. Why?

- 1) The **Academy** initiative has been very successful, and I guess the ultimate accolade was for us to be approached as the preferred partners with the Local Authority, to design and staff the new build school in Langley, Oldbury. We opened in September, and I assumed the role of Chair of Governors, having spent a lot of time recruiting suitable and appropriate colleagues for the Board.

The school, with an ethos based on traditional Christian values, has been highly commended by a School's Inspector (rather similar to Ofsted), and our first intake of Year 7 students seem very happy. They love the new building. My role in both Academies is an honorary one, and I am grateful that Flame is able to support what I do. Already this term, I have found myself engaged in conversation and discussion about Christian values and behaviour, and dare I say it – even with the blatant secularisation of our society – this has generated an inquisitive spirit as to the role of 'spirituality'. 'Bring it on' is my response to new opportunity.

- 2) At last, the **Peace Garden** is being built. Through your kind gifts, supplemented by a very generous donation from Q3, an appropriate space for reflection and celebration is being constructed. Earlier this year, one of our students was tragically killed in a car accident on a zebra crossing, and we found ourselves involved in counselling and drawing alongside family, friends and students. Again I recognise the importance of 'being there' in times of great need, and being able to draw alongside those who were deeply moved and upset. That will be an important function of this new space that we are creating in the grounds of the Great Barr Academy.
- 3) **Ministry** opportunity has been wide and varied. I am choosing more carefully which engagements to put into the diary, but have seen remarkable God-incidents emanating from teaching and sharing. I particularly enjoyed being with local fellowships who want to do church differently in order to impact the community, and opportunity to share my experience has been growing.

## So What About 2017?

You will remember my sharing about some of the involvement with overseas projects – not essentially 'owned' by Flame, but initiatives where sponsors, governing authorities and management, have asked for help and assistance in building vision and strategy for the future.

I shall be returning to **Sparrows** in Johannesburg in January, and I also hope to visit **Rainbow House** in Thailand – the Home for Children with Disabilities – a little later in the Spring. Students and staff from Q3 were there in October and had a life-changing experience. These visits are now firmly embedded in

the Q3 diary as we go forward.



I shall be continuing my work with the Academies, but primarily with the new facility in Langley. The Head of School is a great guy, but is under some personal pressure, as his wife was diagnosed with breast cancer one week before we opened. She has an operation diared for 17<sup>th</sup> February, so please pray.

And while on the subject of prayer, do visit the **Prayer Support** area on our website. This is where you will find specific prayer needs and it will be updated at least every month. I must have sounded perplexed, because he quickly added, 'But Dave, I've never seen the face of my wife, my children or my friends, and yet the first face I shall see, will be that of Jesus'. I must admit to fighting back tears as this came immediately to mind on hearing of Peter's death. 'No more dying there ... he has gone to SEE the King'.
